Head for Dieppe, the patriarch of French seaside resorts. The aristocracy used to visit this town for its baths and it soon overflowed into the neighbouring countryside. You will discover the charms of Varengeville where George Braque died but not before placing his signature on the stained-glass window of the church.

Those interested in lighthouses should not miss visiting the one on Cap d'Ailly in Sainte-Marguerite. Just before arriving at the gorges of Petit-Ailly, follow the Albâtre coast as it rises abruptly up from the sea, and cross through the little valleys of Pays de Caux. Then you see Le Havre facing Honfleur on the other side of the estuary.

Before taking the Normandy bridge, which is as long as the Champs Elysées, you must visit the Sainte-Adresse fort whose local nickname is Napoleon's Hat. On a clear day the site offers the most beautiful view on the Calvados coast.

This newly renovated studio is near the edge of the very small, picturesque town of Tessé-La-Madeleine, near the grounds of a small chateau, surrounded by a wooded park.

FURTHER INFORMATION

The peaceful countryside of the Bocage Ornaïs is within walking distance. Tessé is attached to Bagnoles, a delightfully refined spa town with a wide range of sporting, shopping and cultural facilities as well as a Casino.

Bagnoles is a noted centre for tennis and there are six indoor and six outdoor courts and two at Tessé, the nearest being only 400 yards away. Swimming and horse riding are available and there is fitness centre and an 18 stage obstacle course of 1.4km in the forest, as well as a golf course. A large lake is located nearby where you can take part in a wide range of water sports. You can take part in a variety of other activities including tea-dancing, archery, painting and pottery courses, yoga, boules and much more.

This former old water mill is set 1 three and a half acres of beautiful countryside with streams and waterfalls, tranquillity in itself.

FURTHER INFORMATION

The self contained accommodation is next to the resident English owners home. Perier is the local shopping centre, which is one and a half miles from the Mill. Coutances is 8 miles and Cherbourg is approximately forty miles.

The Mill is an excellent base for touring the numerous sights of Normandy. Manche is rich in seaside activities from swimming, sunbathing and shrimping to regattas, boat trips to the Channel Islands and even sand yachting. Locally to the Mill there is excellent privately owned course and trout fishing for anglers, horse riding, shopping, restaurants and beaches.

As you drive inland, the countryside will seem very English, full of gentle hills, hedgerows and small streams. Probably the most impressive sight here is the Mont st Michael, the magnificent abbeyfortress dominates the landscape for miles around.
