Dordogne-Lot

Rocamadour and St-Cirq-Lapopie leave a lasting impression on any traveller who has the good fortune to visit these astonishingly beautiful villages, located in the northern Lot, one of the départements in Midi-Pyrénées.

The medieval, hillside charm of Rocamadour is best captured by a saying well-known to locals: "Houses along the stream, churches above the houses, rocks above the churches, castles on the rock." Accordingly, a castle towers 420 feet above the Alzou River, dominating the village's medley of old houses, steep streets, ancient churches, and tiny chapels terraced into a sheer cliff.

During the 12th and 13th centuries, thousands of pilgrims on their way to Santiago stopped at Rocamadour to climb the 216 steps that lead to the seven sanctuaries around place St-Amadour. Today you can follow in their footsteps.
